# **Directions to the Reunion**

To get to the park, take I-81 to Exit 47. Go left into town. Follow signs to McDonald's. Turn right at the light. Follow Route 16 to the park. Tell the gate attendant that you are with the Copenhaver reunion and he or she can direct you to Shelter 2.

## **Overnight Rooms**

As in previous years, we have reserved a set of 15 rooms at the Comfort Inn, 5558 Lee Hwy, Atkins, VA, (telephone: 276-783-2144). The cost is \$70.00 per night, plus tax. All rooms have a microfridge and a continental breakfast buffet is included.
